REQUIREMENTS FOR THE FORMATTING OF SCIENTIFIC ARTICLES

The materials should be prepared according to the following requirements.

The manuscript must be prepared using the Word editor, file format – .doc or .docx). Number of pages: minimum – 4, maximum – 10. Sheet format – A4. Margins (mirror): left – 3 cm, top – 2 cm, bottom – 2 cm, right – 1.5 cm. Paragraph indent – 1.25 cm. Line spacing – single. Figures are placed in the center of the page. Captions for the figures – at the bottom in the center; text font: Times New Roman – 12 pt, italic. Tables are placed in the center of the page, and captions must be at the top left above the table, with a paragraph indent (Times New Roman – 12 pt, italic).

Format of papers.

The article begins with the title in Ukrainian, Polish or English, in the center in capital letters (Times New Roman – 12 pt, capital letters, bold).

Surname and name of the author (authors) – on the right (Times New Roman – 12 pt), the number of co-authors – no more than four, placed in one line.

The name of the organization where the author (authors) is educated or works – on the right of the page (Times New Roman – 12 pt). If there is more than one author – the name of the organization is placed on different lines.

Abstract (is required) in the language of the article (Ukrainian, Polish) and in English, at least 1800 characters each (Times New Roman – 10 pt, italic).

The main text of the article (Times New Roman – 12 pt).

List of references (Times New Roman – 12 pt), no more than 15 items. It should be formatted in accordance with current requirements. The sequence of items in the list of references – in the order of mention in the article.
